SATURDAY JUNE 24th

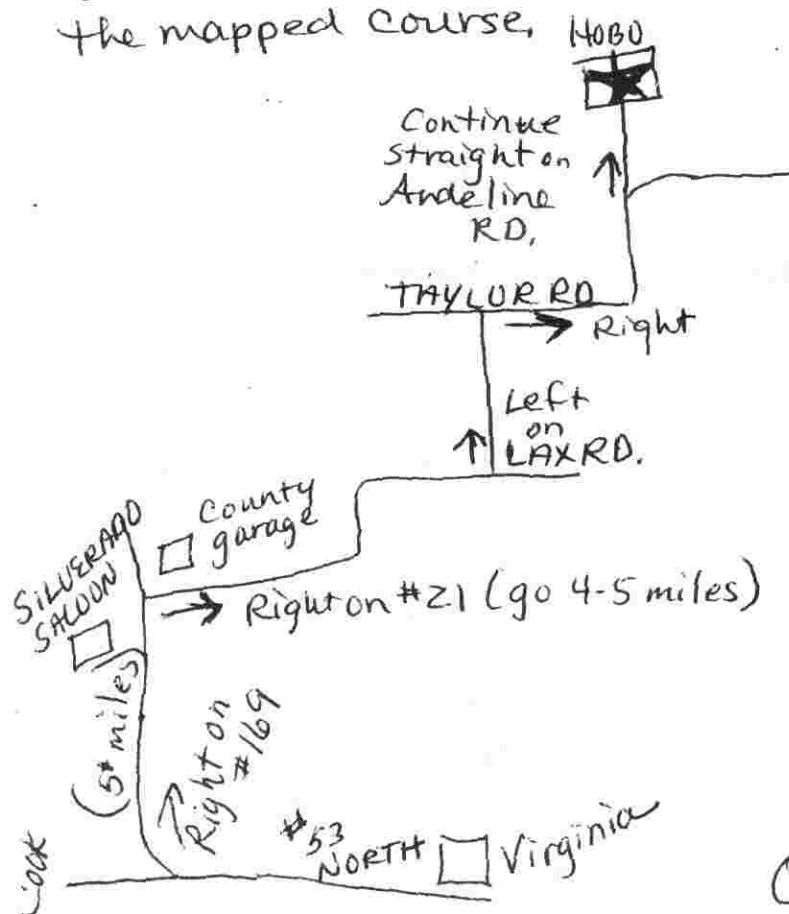
Come on horse riders - get out of your comfort zone and learn a new sport!

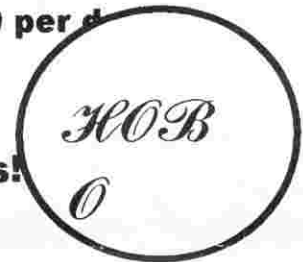

Directions: From Ino, WI (between Ashland and Iron River), at intersection of US 2 and Forest Rt. 236, take Rt. 236 north 9.6 miles to campground sign. Turn right and go about 1 mile then left into campground.

Horseshoe Lake campground is a single loop in a sparse stand of oak and maple trees. Each campsite has a hitching post and picket line. A few sites have a cleared area for portable corral. Rate: \$10 per day camping
